**What We Do:** Designing a multiple cylinder pneumatic circuit.

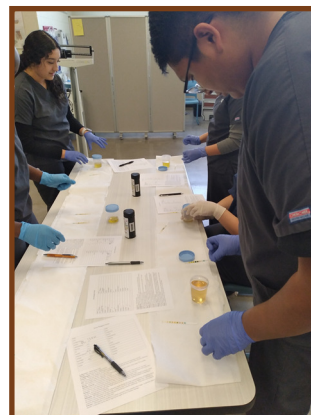


## Medical Assistant I - Ms. Long

#### What We Learn:

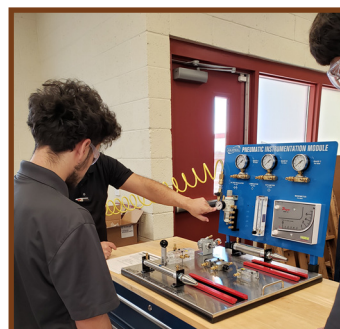
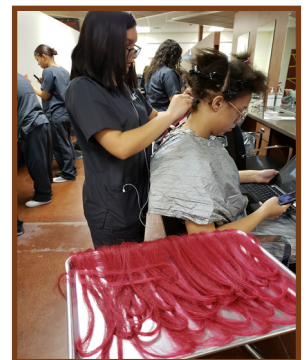
Performing correct sterile drug dosages. **What We Do:** Using a laminar flow hood to produce sterile products along with manipulating one's hands to keep critical areas sterile.
